Synopsis:

On a hot summer day on a dirt road in South Dakota, two young adults almost home, pass a slow-moving tractor. Their head-on collision with another vehicle on the other side of the road and the resulting four deaths isn't uncommon. It happens with regularity on the two-lane dirt highways of rural America. But in that event are all of life's unanswered questions. Why do these things happen? What if they had had one more cup of coffee to drink that day? What if they had had one less cup of coffee? Why do the "good" ones have to die and who gets to decide who the "good" ones are anyway? With the metaphor of a church softball game, a game that everyone understands, we explore the profound questions of life and death and look for understanding. It is simple story; a loyal group of fans hoping for something so small as their church winning a game. Yet, exploring deeper, we see a woman desperately searching for meaning, a group of people searching for community, and a young girl searching for a connection.
